## How the Program Will Work

If you are interested in participating, you'll meet virtually with **Kyshona Armstrong** to write your song. No musical experience is necessary, and at the end you'll have a professional recording of your Lullaby to keep with you forever. You'll create a musical composition of lyrics and music working with Kyshona who will guide the creative process and honor your ideas and preferences. Kyshona will create an audio recording of your lullaby, for you to share with your child and your family for years to come. Intersection will provide additional materials such as a Project Journal and a framed print of your final lullaby lyrics. There is no cost to you for participating. Typically, you will meet with Kyshona for two virtual writing sessions. Intersection will share your final lullaby on our soundcloud page (with just your first name associated with the track) and the final ownership of the song will be shared between you and Kyshona. You will need to sign a partner agreement outlining the full details of the program. This is a fun program designed to foster your creativity and strengthen the beautiful bond between you and your child! We hope you will participate!
